



## Announcement of the Faculty of Engineering, Chiang Mai University

Subject: Call for applications for a lecturer (Position No. EP190059)

The Faculty of Engineering, Chiang Mai University is currently accepting applications for consideration for a lecturer position (No. EP190059) with a monthly salary of 41,000 THB. to work at the Chiang Mai International Engineering School (CM-IES).

The Faculty of Engineering is seeking to recruit a qualified individual to fill the position of Lecturer. We are looking for a candidate with the knowledge and abilities that align with the job description of the vacancy. The details of the announcement are as follows:

### A. Qualification of applicants

1. Must be a person who has general qualifications according to Article 6 of the Regulations of Chiang Mai University, according to Human Resources Management B.E. 2553 (2010)

2. Holds a doctoral degree in **Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Industrial Engineering, Civil Engineering, or a related field**, and have obtained approval for the doctoral degree from the university council

3. Having experience in curriculum publicity, student guidance both domestic and international will be given special consideration

4. Able to support teaching and learning in basic courses for professional work and develop skills for professional work and entrepreneurship or other related courses

5. Have a work experience of organizing an international activities and social activities for students, demonstrate an open, friendly, sociable personality and being able to work with other colleagues appropriately.

6. Applicants must meet the qualifications according to the Chiang Mai University Announcement. Subject: Criteria and Practice Guidelines for English Proficiency Standards of the new full-time lecturers B.E. 2566 (2023) as follows:

6.1 Applicants who hold a doctoral degree from an English program or from an international program with a study duration of no less than 2 years, from a university accredited by the Civil Service Commission, or a doctoral degree from a country where English is the primary language, such as the United Kingdom, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand, are exempt from the English language proficiency requirement.

6.2 Applicants who hold a doctoral degree from a general course in their home country must be proficient in English language. They must achieve a minimum TOEFL Institutional Testing Program (ITP) score of 550, or a minimum TOEFL Computer-based Test (CBT) score of 196, or a minimum TOEFL Internet-based Test (iBT) score of 80. Alternatively, they may have an IELTS (Level) score of at least 6.0 or a CMU-eTEGS (Score) of at least 80.

**B. Date, time and venue**

Those wishing to apply for admission should apply through an electronic recruitment (CMU HR e-Recruitment) on the website <https://hr.oop.cmu.ac.th/recruitment/> for preliminary consideration **from now on until October 11, 2024 (Electronic recruitment system applications will close at 4.30 p.m.)**

**C. Required documents to be submitted in the application (Attach PDF file type documents via CMU HR e-Recruitment system)**

1. A photocopy of degree certificates **at all levels** which shows that applicants have educational qualifications that match the position applied for and must have graduated and be approved by the University Council by the closing date for applications.  
Or a certificate of qualification issued by the educational institution.  
(must be approved by the authorized person before the application deadline.)
2. A photocopy of academic transcripts at all levels
3. A full face photo of the applicant without hat and glasses (3x4 cm. size)  
(attach the photo on CMU HR e-Recruitment system)
4. A photocopy of residence registration
5. A copy of national ID Card (for Thai) or passport (for foreigner)
6. Medical certificate (issued no more than 1 month)
7. A photocopy of English language proficiency scores (according to item 6.2)
8. A photocopy of other evidence such as certificate of change of name – surname (if any)
9. If you are male (Thai nationality), you must have documentation certifying that you have passed military service.
10. Brief curriculum vitae (CV) (if any)

**Remark** All copies of evidence are to be certified by the applicant “I hereby certify that this is a true copy of the original document” and signed signature and date.
